

## **Project Descriptions**

Sewer Lining 2009 – Kokosing Construction Company, Inc. is currently lining several deteriorating and or leaking sanitary sewers in the City of Findlay. The majority of these sewers consist of various river, stream, and ditch crossings. The \$550,000 project is funded with American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funds, Ohio EPA loan funds, and City funds.

Traffic Signal Upgrades – The traffic signals at the intersection of N. Main St. and Howard St., along with the signals at the intersection of N. Main St. and Walnut St. will be upgraded in the upcoming months. The old span-wire hung signals will be replaced with mast-arms and all new equipment. ET Electric Company LLC out of Toledo Ohio will be the contractor performing this \$170,000 improvement.

Sodium Permanganate Feed Facility – Kirk Bros. Co., Inc. and Transtar Electric are almost complete with the Malcolm Pirnie designed facility located at the south end of reservoir #1. This facility is designed to eliminate zebra mussels that have infiltrated the reservoir and restrict water from getting to the Water Treatment Plant. This \$400,000 facility will be completed and operational in July 2010.

2010 Waterline Corrosion Protection: JDR Excavating, Inc. will be performing the work on this project to provide cathodic protection on the existing 16” and 20” waterline on CR99 and CR212. This \$175,000 project will decrease the rapid rate of corrosion on the pipeline.
